### **This cup from Fledglings £4.95 + p&p**

[www.fledglings.org.uk](http://www.fledglings.org.uk) has a 360 degree valve, making it possible to drink from any point on the rim while at the same time preventing a single drop being spilled.

In order to drink you need to start with a small suck but once flowing the valve allows the drink to flow gently, making it suitable for many who have difficulty sucking and swallowing. As the valve seals automatically once lips leave the rim it is also suitable for persons who may need to drink in a reclining position. Families whose child is prone to dropping, throwing or knocking over their drinks may well love this technology.

It also has an illuminated base which comes on automatically and glows in low light. This makes it possible to be used in sensory environments such as a light room or can act as a nightlight in a bedroom while at the same time making essential liquid refreshment available.

The base light lasts for up to 3 months in normal use but can be switched off if not required.
